SILVERSTONE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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1. Trade, vending, display or promotional site

Silverstone Circuits Ltd ("SCL") agrees to provide a trade, vending, display or promotional site(s) (the "Site(s)") to the size and specification set out on the Booking Form at the location within the Silverstone venue (the "Venue") as specified to the trade and/or promotional site operator (the "Operator") and as amended by SCL, at its entire discretion, from time to time. SCL reserves the right to amend plot location of the Site. The Operator represents and warrants that the Site(s) will not exceed the dimensions and specifications set out in the Booking Form. Any items belonging to the Operator which are found outside of those specifications will be removed by SCL, or its representatives at the Operator's sole risk and cost. SCL reserves the right to inspect any Site at its entire discretion and request that reasonable alterations or additions be made.

2. Entrance/vehicle passes

Each Site will entitle the Operator to the following passes on receipt by SCL of full payment in respect of the Site:

- Five entrance passes for each 10m x 10m Site and two vehicle passes
- four entrance passes for each 5m x 10m Site and two vehicle passes
- three entrance passes for each 5m x 5m Site and two vehicle passes valid for each day of the event(s) specified in the Booking Form (the "Event"). Vehicle passes must be clearly displayed at all times. All passes shall be non-transferable and non-refundable.

3. Access

Sites are made available at the times to be advised by SCL; access by the Operator to the Venue prior to and after such times and dates will not be permitted unless agreed in writing by SCL in advance. Set up and breakdown times are as specified by SCL in the confirmation of booking letter.

4. Parking & drop off times

Please note that all vehicles, excluding one stock vehicle per Site subject to availability of space, must be removed to the parking area advised by SCL by 8am on each day of the Event or as otherwise advised by SCL and subject to availability. Vehicle(s) belonging to the Operator (or associated persons) found to be parked in non-car park areas outside of the times permitted for authorised access will be removed from the Venue by SCL at the Operator's risk and cost. Camping is permitted in the designated area only, as advised by SCL. Please note this area is not within the Trade Mall and facilities are limited.

5. Trading times

Sites must be set up prior to the opening time on the 1st trading day, and must not be broken down before the closing time of the last trading day as advised by SCL in the confirmation of booking letter. Failure to adhere to this may result in refusal of future bookings and/or the removal of the Operator from the Venue by SCL at the Operator's risk and cost.

6. Stakes

Under no circumstances may stakes, pins, drives or any other devices be hammered into, or otherwise inserted into, any areas at the Venue. Any damage howsoever caused to any surface or underground services at the Venue will be repaired by SCL and charged to the Operator. Please also note that concrete blocks are not provided by the Venue.

7. Clearing the site

Any litter generated by the Operator, directly or indirectly, must be removed immediately by the Operator and placed in the refuse bins provided. If the Operator is found to be in contravention of this clause, a rubbish removal fee will be charged to the Operator, such fee to be reasonably determined by SCL in its sole discretion. If the Operator has not vacated the Site (and removed all material therefrom) by the time stated on the booking confirmation letter, an additional charge shall be made.

8. Leaflet distribution

It is strictly forbidden for the Operator (or associated personnel) to carry out leaflet distribution at the Venue. If the Operator (or associated personnel) is found to be distributing leaflets, the operator (including associated personnel) shall immediately be required to leave the Venue. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes the leafleting of any vehicles parked at the Venue.

9. Balloons

The Operator is prohibited from selling, giving away, tethering or flying balloons without the express prior written permission of SCL.

10. Advertising

The advertisement by the Operator of any product is permitted only within the Site area.

11. Restrictions of sales

Under no circumstances are the following products to be sold, advertised or promoted by the Operator without the express prior written permission of SCL:

- any film or photography product
- any food, refreshment or beverage
- any product that brings or is likely to bring into question the reputation/goodwill of SCL
- any product the sale of which may endanger/annoy users of the Venue and/or local residents
- any product bearing trade marks (registered or unregistered) belonging to SCL
- any product knowingly obtained by means other than honest and legal
- any product for which another Operator has an exclusive agreement with SCL (a list of such products is available on request).

SCL reserves the full right to exercise absolute discretion when determining whether any product (or advertising) conflicts with the above restrictions. The Operator warrants that it shall have all appropriate licences to sell the merchandise and/or product it intends to sell from such Site.

12. Trading legislation

The Operator agrees to comply with all relevant consumer legislation including, but not limited to, The Trade Description Acts, The Consumer Protection Act 1987, The Supply of Goods and Services Act 1994 and The Gambling Act 2005 (this includes, but is not limited to, tombola's, prize draws, raffles and competitions).

13. Fire extinguishers

Each Operator must provide a certified fire extinguisher of a specification consistent with relevant fire and health safety regulations applicable at the time. The Operator is responsible for ensuring that the fire extinguisher is fully operational and that all

persons within the Site are trained fully in the use of such equipment. SCL reserves the right to inspect any Site at its entire discretion and request that reasonable alterations or additions be made.

14. Animals

Animals are not permitted access to the Venue, with the exception of Guide Dogs, Hearing Dogs and Caring Dogs.

15. Conduct

Without prejudice to clause 11 above, and whilst at the Venue, the Operator (and any associated personnel) shall at all times conduct affairs in a manner which shall not bring into question, or be likely to bring into question, the reputation and/or goodwill of SCL. In particular, but without limitation, the Operator (and associated personnel) shall not act in a way, which constitutes, or is likely to constitute, a nuisance to members of the public and Venue users generally. The Operator acknowledges and agrees that SCL reserves the right to remove the Operator from the Venue where SCL is of the opinion (at its absolute discretion) that the Operator (and associated personnel) is acting in breach of this clause.

16. Payment

The Operator, at the time of booking, shall provide SCL with a valid credit card number. Once a signed Booking Form has been received by SCL, SCL will take full payment for the Site. For amounts over £1000.00 (excluding VAT) a cheque will be accepted and this should be made payable to 'Silverstone Circuits Limited'. Payments by cheque will not be accepted less than 14 days prior to the event. If the booking is made less than 14 days prior to the event, and is over £1000 (excluding VAT) then a BACS transfer or CHAPS transfer or credit card will be accepted. The Operator by signing the Booking Form agrees to these payment terms.

17. Future requests for a site

SCL reserves the right to refuse any future applications from the Operator for Sites at any Venue operated by SCL. Without prejudice to this absolute right of refusal, SCL will take account of its past dealings with the Operator and, in particular, the presentation of the Site and any delay occasioned in settling amounts due from the Operator under the Booking Form.

18. Indemnity

The Operator shall at all times indemnify and hold harmless SCL, its licensees, employees, directors, officers and agents from and against any and all claims, costs, losses, liabilities and damages (including that of personal property) howsoever arising in connection with any negligence, recklessness, breach of these terms & conditions or willful misconduct of the Operator, its employees, customers or clients, arising out of, or in connection with, the use of the Site. The Operator must have, and shall provide to SCL a copy of its Public Liability Insurance with a minimum amount of £5million cover.

19. Cancellation

In the event of an Operator wishing to alter or cancel the booking the Operator must confirm any such alteration/cancellation in writing to SCL who shall exercise its sole discretion in deciding whether to accept such cancellation/alteration. On receipt of such a notice of cancellation/alteration and subject to SCL accepting such cancellation/

alteration SCL shall be entitled to charge a cancellation fee equal to 100% of the Site as priced on the booking form where such notice of cancellation has been received by SCL less than 7 days prior to the first day of the Booked Event.

20. Limitation of liability

20.1 The following provisions set out the entire financial liability of SCL (including any liability for the acts or omissions of its employees, agents and sub-contractors) to the Operator in respect of a) any breach of these terms and conditions, and b) any representation, statement or tortious act or omission including negligence arising under or in connection with the provision of the Site.

20.2 All warranties, conditions and other terms implied by statute or common law (save for conditions implied by section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979) are, to the fullest extent permitted by law, excluded from these terms & conditions.

20.3 Nothing in these terms & conditions excludes or limits the liability of SCL for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of SCL.

20.4 Subject to clauses 20.1 and 20.2: a) the liability of SCL in contract, tort, (including negligence or breach of statutory duty), misrepresentation, or otherwise, arising in connection with the performance or contemplated performance of the provision of the Site, shall be limited to the fee agreed with the Operator for the provision of the Site, and b) SCL shall not be liable to the Operator for any indirect/ consequential loss or damage (whether for loss of profit/business or otherwise) costs, expenses or other claims for consequential compensation (howsoever caused), which arise out of, or in connection with, the provision of a Site.

20.5 For the avoidance of doubt the Operator agrees and accepts that SCL shall have no liability in respect of any theft, break-in or trespass of the Site and under no circumstances will any refund be provided by SCL due to inclement weather and/or disruption or cancellation of the Event.

21. Risk assessments

The Operator shall provide to SCL copies of all health and safety policies, risk assessments and lists of any contractors and any applicable risk assessments from such contractors relevant to its activities at Silverstone and ensure that all such policies and/or risk assessments are suitable and sufficient and compliant with all relevant legislation.

22. Application of terms & conditions

The terms & conditions set out above are supplemental to any terms & conditions governing the Booking Form, such terms & conditions to remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict or dispute between these terms & conditions and those on the Booking Form, the former shall prevail unless the parties agree otherwise. The Operator agrees and acknowledges that by signing the Booking Form, and in consideration of SCL granting the rights to a Site, the terms & conditions stated above shall apply at all times.

23. Charities

For the avoidance of doubt, these terms and conditions also apply to all registered charities and charitable organisations operating a trade, vending, display or promotional site at SCL.
