TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Silverstone Festival is an event that will take place on (22 24 August 2025) and the event's Fun Run is organised by Silverstone Circuits Ltd whose address is Silverstone Circuit, Towcester, Northamptonshire, United Kingdom, NN12 8TN.
- 2. Race Against Dementia is a registered charity (Charity No. 1165559) that funds innovative global research into the prevention and cure of dementia.
- 3. The Fun Run at Silverstone Festival is held in support of Race Against Dementia. A minimum donation of £10 should be made to the charity by each participant.
- 4. The Fun Run is a single lap of the track (a little over 5K), which will be taking place on Friday 22nd August as an integral part of Silverstone Festival.
- 5. The Fun Run will start upon the direction of race control, after the last grid of the day has qualified on track. This is likely to be 19:15.
- 6. The Fun Run is open to those aged 10 and above. Children aged 10-15 must be accompanied at all times while on track by a responsible adult.
- 7. Parents/guardians must sign a disclaimer form for all children aged 10 17.
- 8. It is an event for runners and each runner should be capable of completing the distance within one hour. We ask that walkers do not take part in this event. Wheelchair users who wish to enquire about wheelchair participation should email the organisers at: enquiries@silverstone.co.uk.
- 9. All runners must ensure they are wearing appropriate clothing and footwear.
- 10. To be eligible to take part in the Fun Run, each participant shall:
- a. Hold a <u>valid ticket</u> to gain admission to Silverstone Festival on Friday 22 August; and
- b. Register to take part. Registrations are possible online until 17:00 on Friday 15 August. After this time, registrations are possible in person at the event at the Race Against Dementia stand (in the Fan Zone) before 17:00 on Friday 22 August; and

- c. Complete and sign a <u>disclaimer form</u> on the day of the event (or where under the age of 18, this shall be completed by a parent or guardian), make a donation of £10 to Race Against Dementia and collect a wristband at the Race Against Dementia stand (in the Fan Zone) on Friday 22 August prior to 17:00; and
- d. Wear the wristband provided by Race Against Dementia for the Fun Run in order to be permitted access to the track at the start of the Run.
- e. Arrive at the National Paddock assembly area by 19:00.
- 11. A tail runner will be in full contact with race control throughout the Run and spotters in race control will be monitoring the Run and will advise the team on-the-ground of any issues they may identify.
- 12. Anyone arriving to take part in the Run after the tail runner has departed will not be permitted to take part.
- 13. Anyone thought to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to take part.
- 14. All runners must follow the directions of Silverstone Festival and the Race Against Dementia teams at all times.
- 15. The Fun Run cannot be guaranteed and is subject to the weather and track schedule. In the event that the Fun Run has to be cancelled, charity donations will not be refunded.
- 16. All runners choosing to participate do so entirely at their own risk and neither: Silverstone Circuits Limited; British Racing Drivers Club; the promoters of Silverstone Festival, Goose Live Events Limited; nor Race Against Dementia, will be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, cost or expense which may be suffered or incurred as a result of taking part in this activity except where this is caused by the negligence of Silverstone Circuits Limited; the British Racing Drivers Club; Goose Live Events Limited; or Race Against Dementia.
