

KEEPING YOU SAFE

We've taken precautions to keep you safe on-site, but please read through the following information and advice to make sure everyone has a safe and enjoyable stay.

⇒ FIRE

There are fire points and rotary alarms around the site, powder fire extinguishers can be found at the Driving Range for use in an emergency. Please familiarise yourself with these areas when you arrive. In the event of a fire no matter how small:

- Raise the alarm by shouting 'Fire' and using the rotary alarm.
- Call the fire brigade and then inform a member of staff or call the number above.
- If attempting to extinguish the fire use the correct extinguisher for the fire type.
- Turn off gas and electrics and leave the area to report to the person in charge at the assembly point.

⇒ STAYING SAFE

Northamptonshire Police will be at Silverstone from Wednesday-Monday. Please follow the crime prevention advice below.

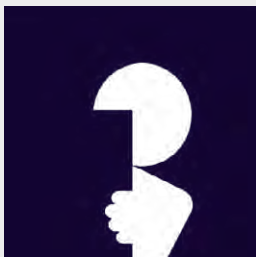

⇒ RESPONDING TO A FIREARMS OR WEAPONS ATTACK



RUN

- If there is a safe route, RUN, if not hide
- Insist others go with you
- Don't let them slow you down
- Leave your belongings behind



HIDE

- If you can't run, HIDE
- Find cover from gunfire
- Be aware of your exits
- Lock yourself in a room if you can
- Move away from the door
- Be very quiet, turn off your phone
- Barricade yourself in



TELL

- Call the police when you are safe
- Give your location
- Describe the attacker
- Can you safely stop others from entering the area
