KEEPING CUSTOMERS SAFE

Our Team are committed to providing Track Days which are safe and enjoyable for all. Following the latest Government update and relaxation of Covid-19 prevention measures in England we have introduced some changes to the way our Track Days are run.



REGISTRATION

- ⇒ All pre-event registration will continue to be completed online, in advance. You will be sent links by email to complete these in the days before your event
- ⇒ On arrival, participants will be required to collect and apply their own wristbands
- ⇒ A member of staff will be present in the wristband collection area, behind a Perspex safety screen, to visually check licences and deal with any issues and queries
- ⇒ Hand sanitiser will be widely available



TRACK DAY BRIEFINGS

- ⇒ Briefings for all Track Days are carried out online, you'll be emailed a unique link to view this in the run up to your event. You must watch this at least 48 hours before your event
- ⇒ A short safety reminder briefing will take place on the day, our registration team will confirm the time and location of this when you arrive



GARAGES & PADDOCK AREAS

- ⇒ In line with the latest Government advice there will be no restrictions on the number of vehicles or people in Garage or Paddock Areas, however we recommend attendees are cautious and should you feel more comfortable in doing so please wear a mask and maintain social distancing



FOOD & DRINK

- ⇒ The Silverstone Team will be able to direct you to the relevant catering area on the day. One way systems may be in place, we ask that you follow any one way signage or staff guidance in these scenarios
- ⇒ All attendees are welcome to bring their own food and drink



ADDITIONAL POINTS

- ⇒ All payments are to be made by credit or debit card, we are currently unable to accept cash payments
- ⇒ Helmet Hire will be available, all of our helmets go through a strict cleansing process between each use
- ⇒ Attendees are welcome to bring guests to our Track Day. Please note that anyone under the age of 16 is not permitted in the Pit Lane and must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- ⇒ You may notice that we will continue to enforce some Covid-19 prevention measures with our staff, with the use of protective screens, face masks and social distancing. This is nothing to worry about and is focussed on ensuring our team stay as safe as possible to allow us to continue to deliver unforgettable events throughout the summer
